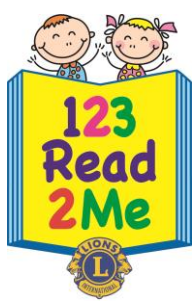


123Read2Me Bullet Points

- **123Read2Me Limited** is a start-up Australian Company limited by guarantee, founded in 2015.
- We hold Australian Public Benevolent Institution and Registered Charity status through the Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission (ACNC).
- We hold Deductible Gift Recipient (DGR) Tier 1 and Tax Concession Charity status with the ATO
- There are over 730,000 children in Australia living in poverty today and we know that when you are struggling to put food on the table, children's books are a luxury.
- International research is unequivocal.
 - Reading aloud to young children every day builds the necessary brain architecture to underpin success in school and throughout their lives, thereby breaking the cycle of poverty.
 - Waiting until the child starts school is too late. They will never catch up.
- Our vision: "*All children have quality books and someone who reads to them every day*".
- Our goal: To give every child living in poverty in Australia one book every two weeks.
 - This means we have to collect, sort, pack and ship 73,000 books a day!
- 123Read2Me currently provides free children's books (new and recycled) to at-risk children in a non-threatening, no expectations, open manner to ensure that even the "service-avoiders" can participate.
- The total value of books donated to date exceeds \$2,000,000.00 (replacement value).
- Books are distributed via FREE BOOK BOXES in locations target children / families frequent, including:
 - Fish & Chip shops (Operation Take Away)
 - Centrelink offices
 - Local Government Maternal & Child Health Centres
 - Local Playgroups & Kindergartens and Primary Schools
 - Local Child Care Centres
 - Frankston Hospital – Emergency, Outpatients, Pediatric and Maternity Department Waiting Rooms
 - Nairn Marr Djambana, the Gathering Place of the Bunurong people
- We currently support the work of over 50 organisations, most operating in the Greater Dandenong, Casey, Bayside, Frankston and Mornington Peninsula Local Government Areas.
 - We were also the supplier (donor) of books for the Victorian Department of Education & Early Childhood Development, Northern Peninsula Principal's Network's Oral Language Program 2017/18 for pre-school children because too many are starting school without the minimum vocabulary necessary.
- 123Read2Me Children's Book Project is a Club project of the Lions Club of Mordialloc Mentone since 2014
- 123Read2Me Children's Book Project is a District Project of the Lions Clubs of 201V5 since Oct 2017.
- We are in advanced planning stages to add cover to Victoria's Western suburbs and Regional centres within the next year.
- The project is forecast to expand nationally within 3 years and internationally by the mid 2020's.



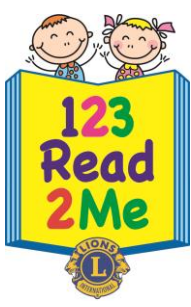
